Nest Seekers International and Habitat for Humanity, took over Times Square for a day of festivities in the spirit of giving back during the holidays. Nest Seekers International CEO Eddie Shapiro joined Habitat for Humanity's Senior Vice President Larry Gluth to ring the NASDAQ Stock Market opening bell.

Shapiro and Gluth reteamed in the evening at NASDAQ World Headquarters for "Repair, Rebuild, Restore, a Holiday Benefit for Habitat for Humanity Hosted by Nest Seekers International."

"The devastation caused by Hurricane Sandy was unfathomable. 60 people died in New York State, 41 in New York City alone. a holiday party, we decided to focus our resources on the victims still suffering from the devastation of Sandy."
